SQL Fundamentals – LOGICAL OPERATORS

Create SQL commands to provide information for the following problems.

- 1. AW2008: List employees who are female AND have 'Marketing Specialist' as their job title. Show the Business Entity ID, organization level, job title, and gender.
- 2. AW2008: List all employees who have 'Marketing Specialist' as their job title. Show the Business Entity ID, organization level, job title, and gender.
- 3. AW2008: List employees who are marketing assistant OR marketing specialist. Show the Business Entity ID, organization level, and job title.
- 4. AW2008: List employees who are application specialist OR marketing specialist AND vacation hours are greater than 73 or marital status = 'M" (married). Show the Business Entity ID, job title, vacation hours and marital status.

What to do:

- 1. In one file write all the SQL commands.
- 2. Before each command add the problem statement as a comment line.
- 3. The file must be simple text file with a TXT or SQL file extension. File need to be saved with your last name SQL STATEMENT USED, and your name should be included in a comment line format
- 4. Test your commands and make sure they are error-free before submitting the solution file.
